CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION FACILITIES GRANT PROGRAM - RESERVATION OF FUNDS



The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) is conducting a free interactive workshop to provide information to Local Educational Agencies regarding the Reservation of Funds process for Career Technical Education Facilities Program. Training will be provided on what it means to request a Reservation of Funds, the various timelines associated with projects that request a Reservation of Funds, and how those timelines interact with the Priority in Funding Process.

Topics include:

- Brief introduction to the Career Technical Education Facilities Program.
- What requesting a Reservation of Funds means for your project.
- What the timeline is to obtain CDE and DSA Plan Approvals on your Reservation of Funds project.
- What the timeline is to submit a complete *Fund Release Authorization* (Form SAB 50-05).
- How these timelines interact with the Priority in Funding process.
- When do you have to be under contract/break ground on your project.
- How much time is allowed to finish your project.
