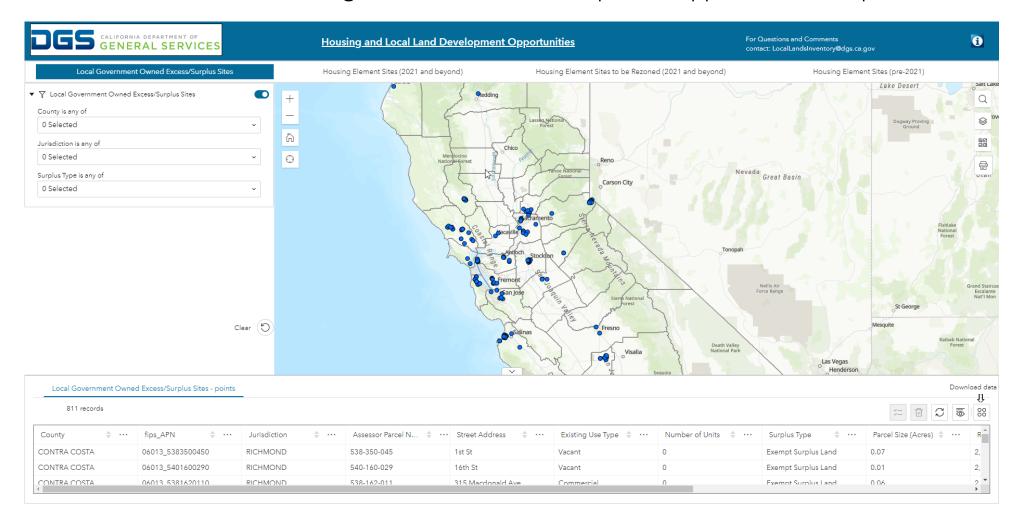


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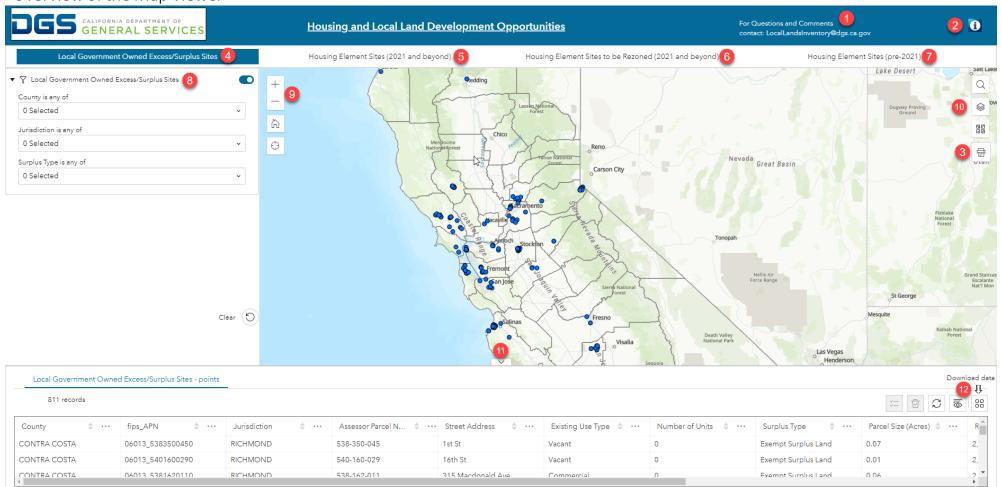
Terms

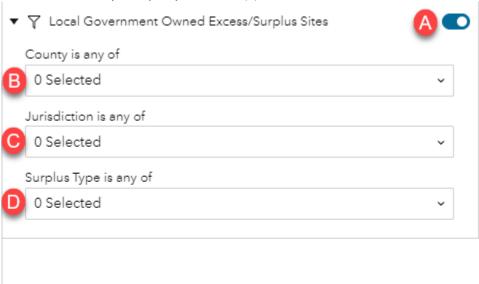

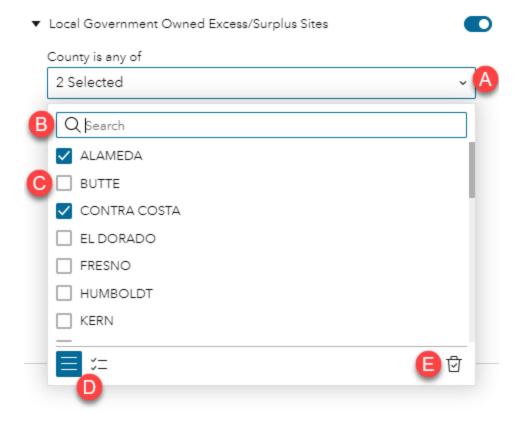
Performing a Query (Local Government Owned Excess/Surplus Sites Data)

- 1. Search Options You can search by single options or combine options. For example, you can select from county, or you could select county and jurisdiction:
 - a. Turn Query Results on or off
 - b. Select by county from the dropdown list (you can choose multiple)
 - c. Select by jurisdiction from the dropdown list (you can choose multiple)
 - d. Select by surplus designation
 - e. Clear your query selection(s)

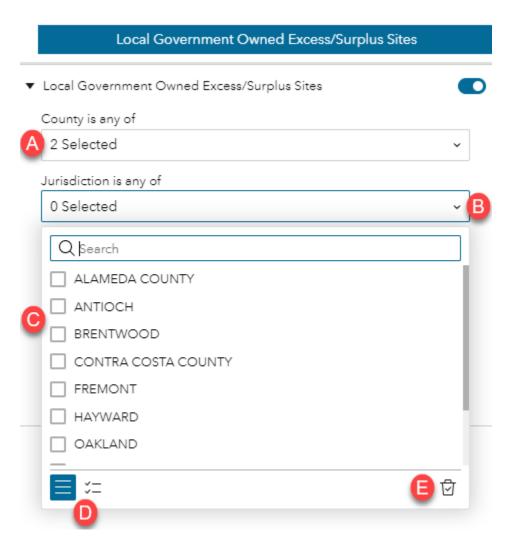




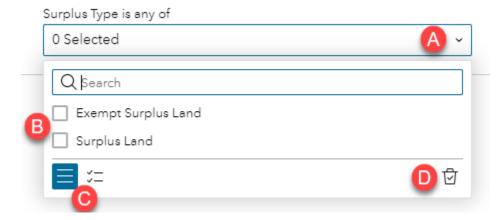
- 2. Search by County:
 - a. Click the drop-down arrow to open the county selections
 - b. You can quickly search by a county name
 - c. Select the check box of counties you wanted included in the query
 - d. You can choose to view all counties or only the ones you have selected
 - e. Select the trash can you remove all selections from the drop-down



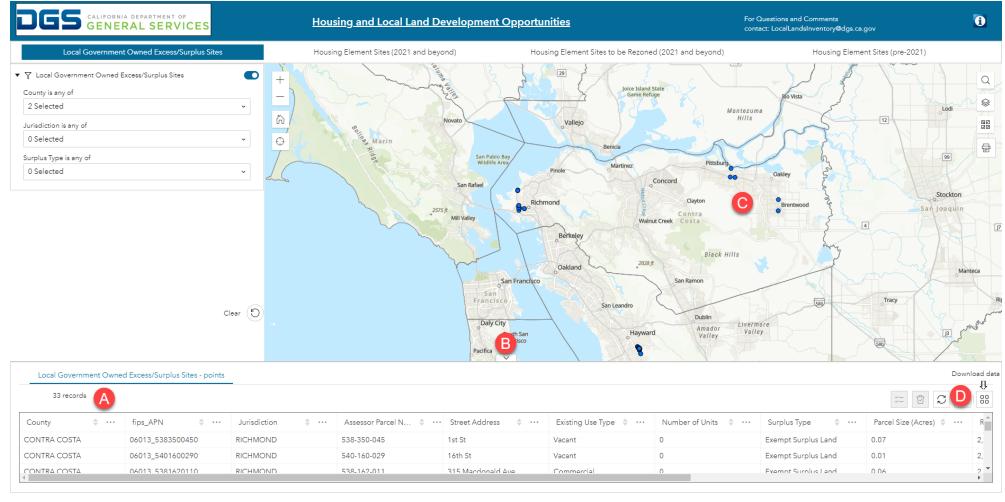
- 3. Search by Jurisdiction:
 - a. The counties selected in the previous step are shown
 - b. Click the drop-down arrow to open the jurisdiction selections
 - c. The results have been filtered to only show jurisdictions in the counties you previously selected
 - d. You can choose to view all counties or only the ones you have selected
 - e. Select the trash can you remove all selections from the drop-down



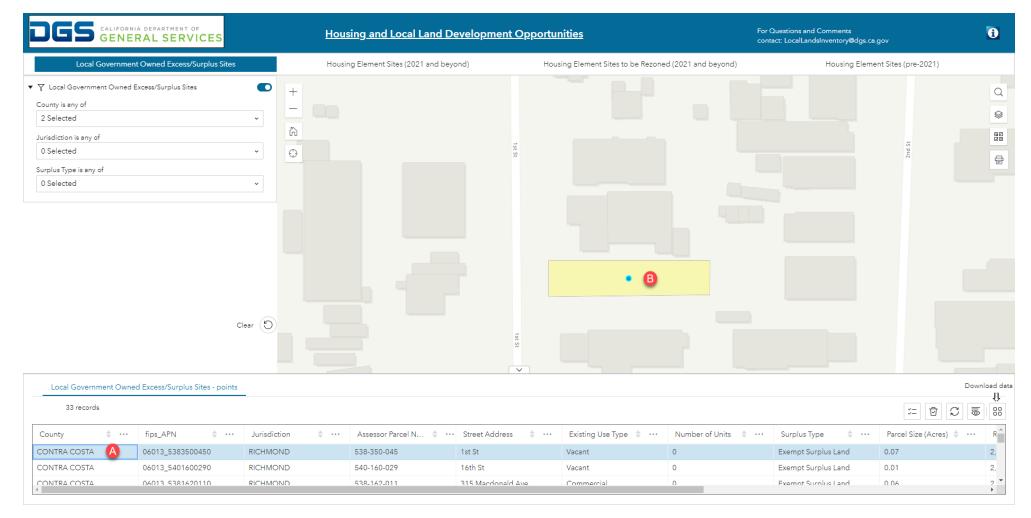
- 4. Search by Surplus Type:
 - a. Click the drop-down arrow to open the Surplus Designation selections
 - b. Select the check box of Surplus Type you wanted included in the query
 - c. You can choose to view all counties or only the ones you have selected
 - d. Select the trash can you remove all selections from the drop-down



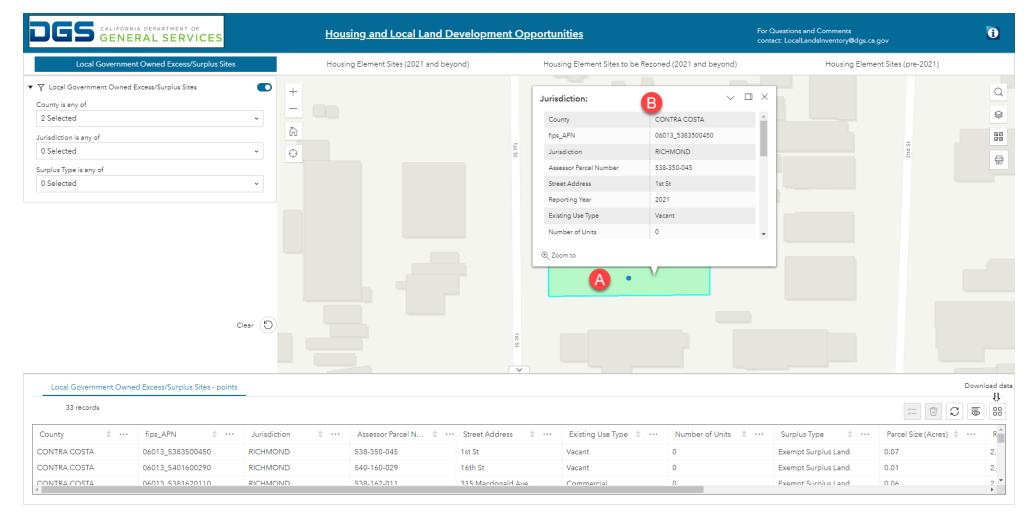
- 5. Viewing your results in the Attribute Table and Map:
 - a. The Attribute Table will display your Query results
 - b. Open/Collapse Attribute Table
 - c. The map will zoom to your results (Alameda and Contra Costa Counties)
 - d. Select the Download Data button to export your query results into a CSV (Excel read) file



- 6. Selecting a record in the Attribute Table:
 - a. Select a record in the Attribute Table
 - b. The map will zoom to the record you selected and will blink yellow

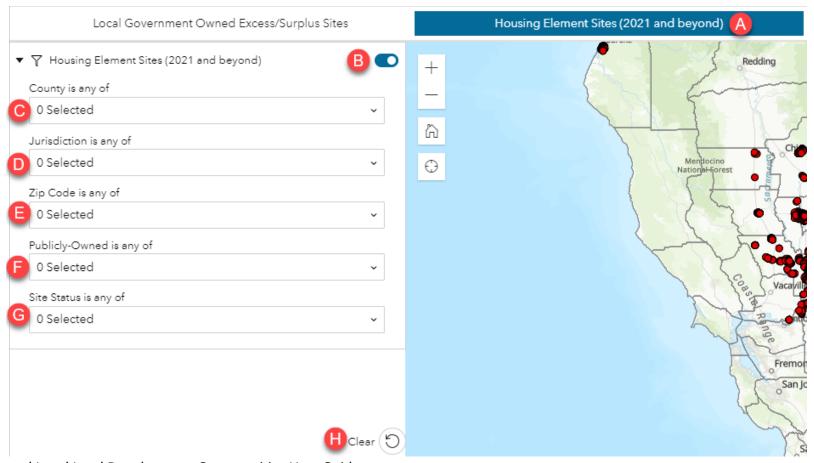


- 7. Selecting a parcel on the map:
 - a. Select a parcel polygon on the map
 - b. A pop-up window will appear with information related to your selection



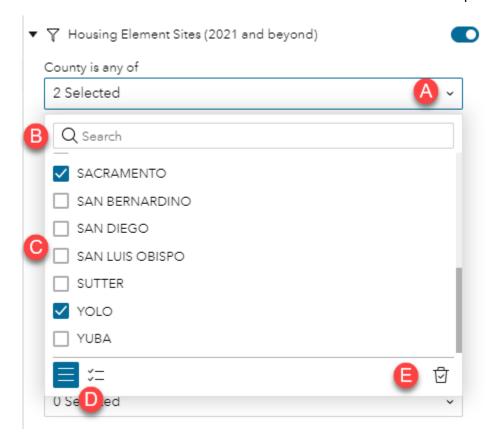
Performing a Query (Housing Element Sites (2021 and beyond) Data)

- 1. Search Options You can search by single options or combine options. For example, you can select from county or you could select from county and jurisdiction:
 - a. Select the Housing Element Sites (2021 and beyond) Data tab
 - b. Turn Query Results on or off
 - c. Select by County from the dropdown list (you can choose multiple)
 - d. Select by Jurisdiction from the dropdown list (you can choose multiple)
 - e. Select by zip code from the dropdown list (you can choose multiple)
 - f. Select a Public-Owned from the dropdown list (you can choose multiple)
 - g. Select a Site Status (you can choose multiple)
 - h. Clear you query selections



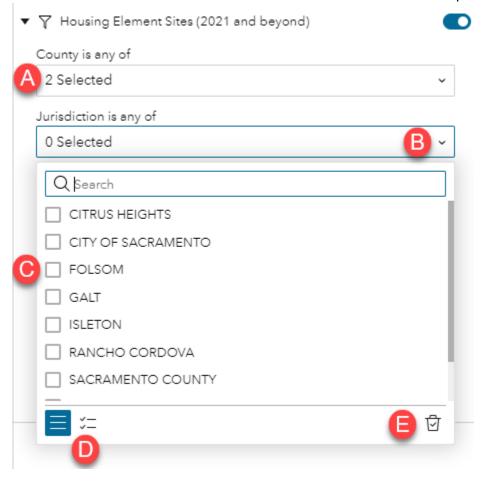
2. Search by County:

- a. Click the drop-down arrow to open the county selections
- b. You can quickly search by county name
- c. Select the check boxes of the counties you would like included in the query
- d. Choose to view all counties or only the ones you have selected
- e. Select the trash can to remove all selections from the drop-down



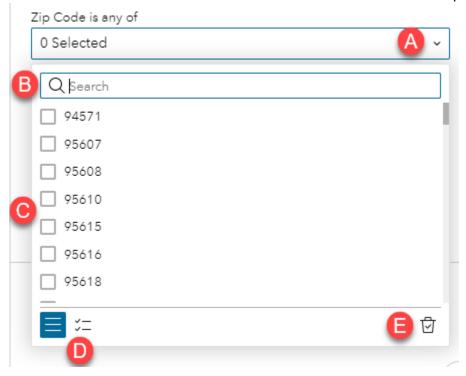
3. Search by Jurisdiction:

- a. The counties selected in the previous step are shown
- b. Click the drop-down arrow to open the jurisdiction selection
- c. The results have been filtered to only show jurisdictions in the counties you previously selected
- d. Choose to view all counties or only the ones you have selected
- e. Select the trash can to remove all selections from the drop-down

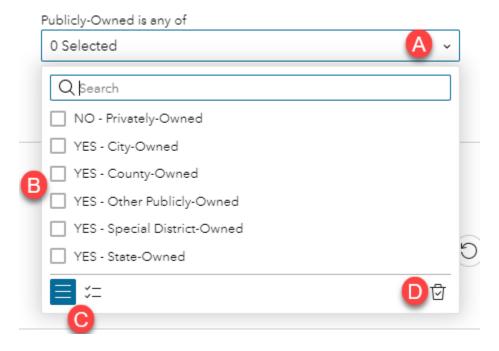


4. Search by Zip Code:

- a. Click the drop-down arrow to open the zip code selections
- b. Enter in a zip code you want to select
- c. Click the checkbox of the zip codes you want included in your query results
- d. Choose to view all zip codes or only the ones you have selected
- e. Select the trash can to remove all selections from the drop-down

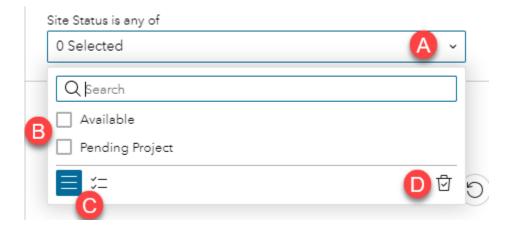


- 5. Search by Publicly-Owned:
 - a. Click the drop-down arrow to open the Public-Owned selections
 - b. Click the checkbox of the options you want included in your query results
 - c. Choose to view all options or only the ones you have selected
 - d. Select the trash can to remove all selections from the drop-down

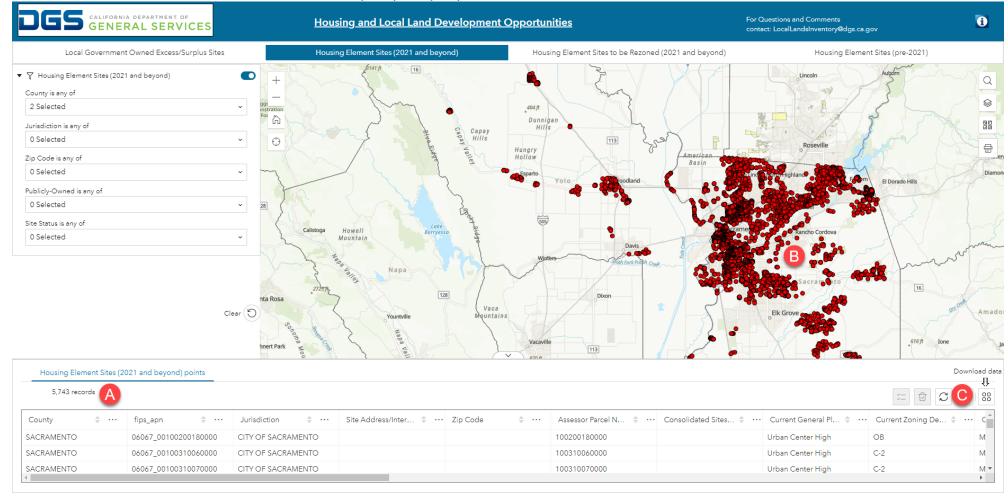


6. Search by Site Status:

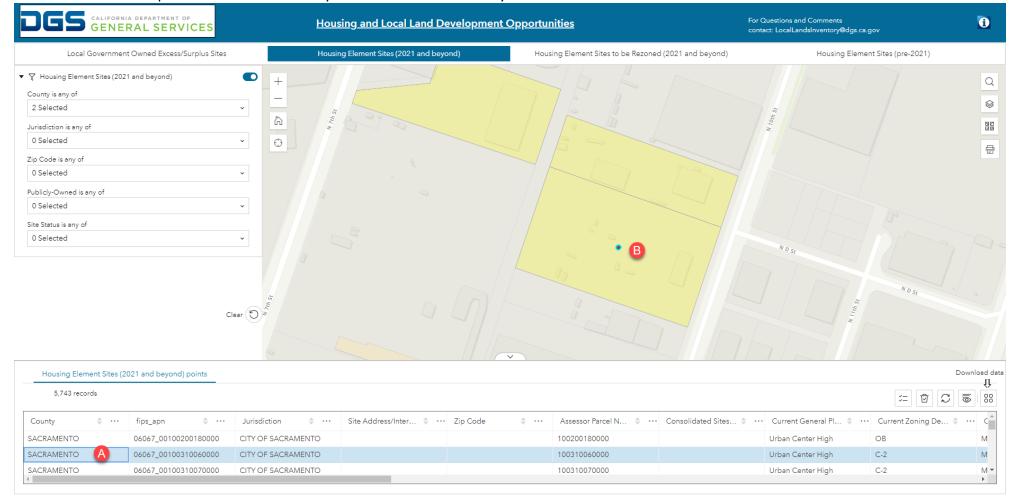
- a. Click the drop-down arrow to open the Site Status selections
- b. Click the checkbox of the options you want included in your query results
- c. Choose to view all options or only the ones you have selected
- d. Select the trash can to remove all selections from the drop-down



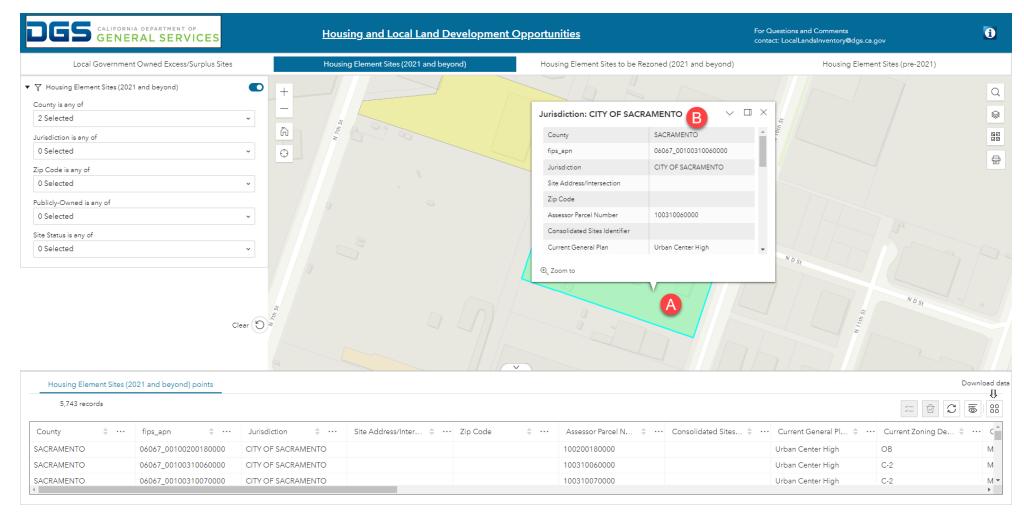
- 7. Viewing your results in the Attribute Table and Map:
 - a. The Attribute Table will display your Query results
 - b. The map will zoom to your results (Sacramento and Yolo Counties)
 - c. Select the Download Data button to export your query results into a CSV Excel file



- 8. Selecting a record in the Attribute Table:
 - a. Select a record in the Attribute Table
 - b. The map will zoom to the record you selected and will blink yellow



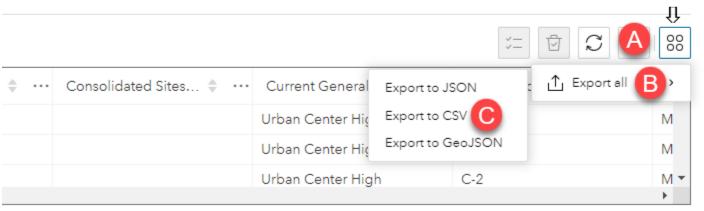
- 9. Selecting a parcel on the map:
 - a. Select a parcel polygon on the map
 - b. A pop-up window will appear with information related to your selection



Exporting Search Results

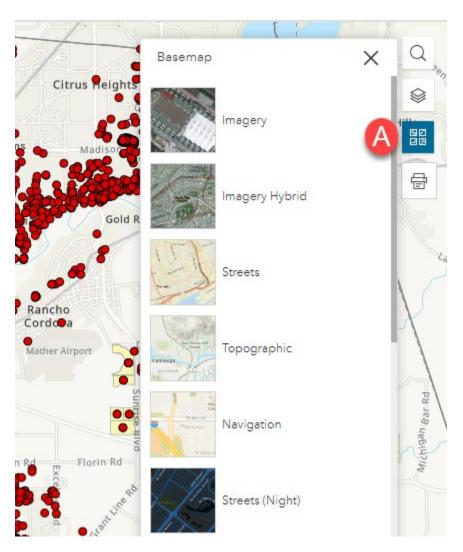
- 1. How to Export Search Results from the Attribute Table:
 - d. Click the Download Data button on the far right of the attribute table
 - e. Select the Export All option
 - f. Select the Export to CSV option (an excel file can be found in your browser downloads)





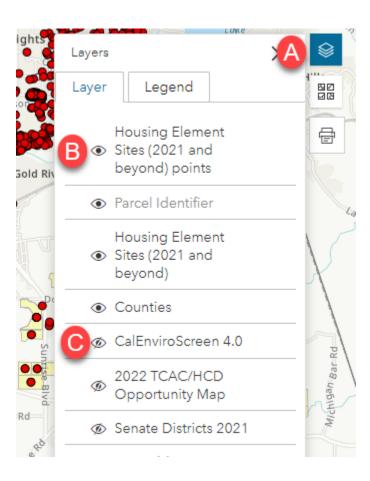
Changing the Basemap

- 1. Change your Basemap:
 - a. Click the Basemap button to select from the available option to change the background image



Viewing the Layer List

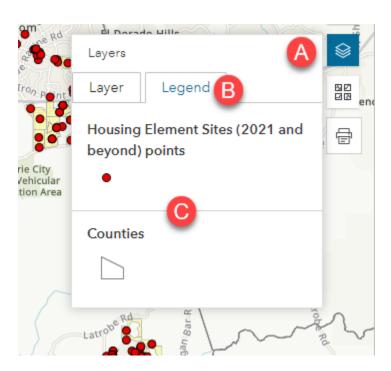
- 1. Layer List:
 - a. Click the Layers button to view all Layers available on the Map
 - b. A layer with an eye shows that the layer is currently active/visible on the map
 - c. A layer with a slash through the eye shows a layer available on the map but is not currently active/visible on the map. You can click the eyeball to toggle the layers visibility on the map on or off



Viewing the Legend

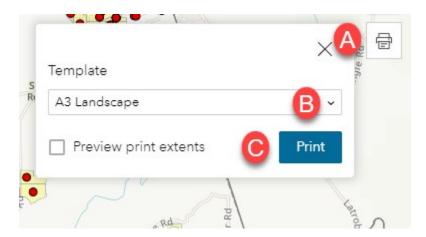
1. Legend:

- a. Click the Layers button to bring up the Layers and Legends tabs
- b. Select the Legend tab to view active/visible Layers on the map
- c. Layers currently active/visible on the map will display with their unique symbol and name



Printing a Map

- 1. Print Function:
 - a. Click the Print button to open the print window
 - b. Select the print format for the map
 - c. Click Print



d. Select the map name to download your printed map into PDF format
