CHAPTER 23 WOOD

. . .

2304.12.2.5 Supporting members for permeable floors and roofs. Wood structural members ... separated from such floors or roofs by an impervious moisture barrier. [BSC, DSA-SS, DSA-SS/CC, HCD 1, HCD 2] The impervious moisture barrier system protecting the structure supporting floors shall provide positive drainage of water that infiltrates the moisture permeable floor topping.

This oversight was identified after the closing of the 45-day comment period.
