Kevin:

I apologize for my delay in getting comments to you.

My primary comment remains Section 1502.3. I do not believe that DDW or many recycled water retailers would like to have the ability to interconnect potable water with recycled water without an air gapped connection between the two. I would recommend modifying this section as follows:

1502.3 Connections to Potable and Reclaimed (Recycled) <u>Recycled</u> reclaimed (recycled) <u>recycled</u> Water Systems. Gray water systems shall have no <u>unprotected</u> connection to a potable water supply, on-site treated nonpotable water supply, or reclaimed (recycled) water systems. Potable, on-site treated nonpotable, water, <u>or rainwater</u> is permitted to be used as makeup water for a non-pressurized storage tank provided the connection is protected by an airgap, <u>reduced pressure principle backflow preventer</u>, <u>or other physical device which prevents backflow in accordance with this code</u>.
