Cal Water is supportive of the draft initial CPC express terms, proposed amendments, identified in the attached

Our primary interests / concerns are:

- Supporting the expanded beneficial use of recycled water through the use of recycled water in new residential and non-residential construction
- Insuring any changes to the CPC are consistent with current regulations established for the use of recycled water
- Insuring the requirements for the Authority Having Jurisdiction in implementing, permitting and overseeing CPC provisions are clear and practical.
- Noting the use of recycled water for residential in-door, non-irrigation use (toilets, urinals) will be problematic, and CPC regulations for this use will require particular scrutiny
