You will notice that the tabs have changed a bit. Let's take a quick tour through the new tabs:



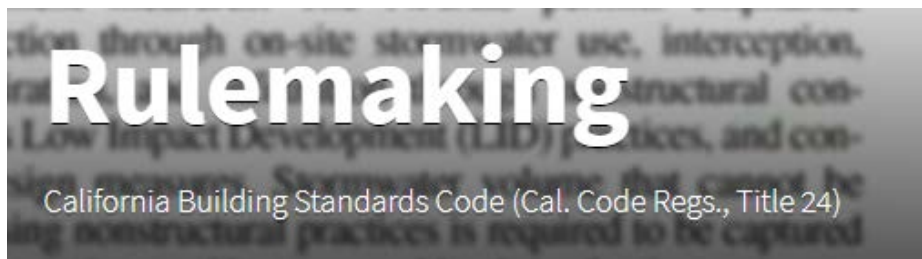
The **Home** page now includes our **Featured Links**, which are:

- The current code adoption cycle (Rulemaking tab)
- The current edition of Title 24 (Codes tab)
- Local code ordinances (Codes tab)
- CALGreen information and checklists (Resources tab)
- Building Permit Fees
- Education and Outreach

The **Codes** tab has links to the currently published edition of Title 24, including errata and supplements. Access to Local Code Ordinances is also provided on the Codes tab.



The **Rulemaking** tab provides access to current and past code adoption cycle activities and information, including proposing and adopting agency submittals, emergency rulemaking activities and special subcommittees.



The **Forms** tab provides quick access to CBSC forms, and rulemaking forms, templates and checklists. See the Resources tab for CALGreen checklists.



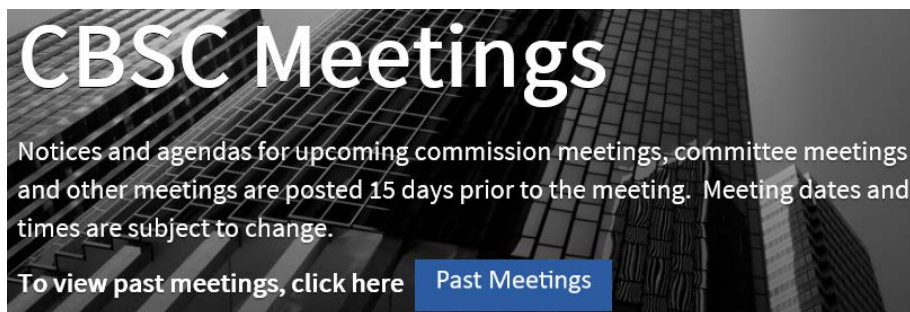
The **Resources** tab highlights our educational publications, and has another link to the CALGreen page.



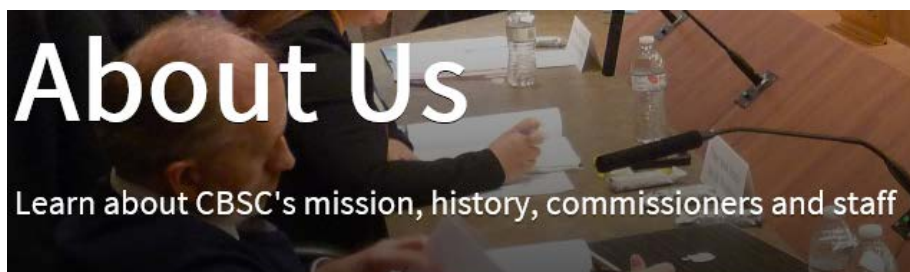
The **News** tab includes CALCode Quarterly newsletters and CBSC Information Bulletins.
