

**NOTICE OF 3rd 45-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR
PROPOSED BUILDING STANDARDS FOR THE
CALIFORNIA BUILDING STANDARDS CODE, TITLE 24,
of the CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS,
DIVISION OF THE STATE ARCHITECT**

The California Building Standards Commission (CBSC), on behalf of the Division of the State Architect, is providing notice of code changes intended for the 2019 California Building Standards Code, that were the subject of comments during the Commission meeting held July 13, 14, and 15, 2020

CBSC will accept written comments for at least 45 days between **August 4** and **September 18, 2020**. All written comments for this period must be submitted no later than midnight on **September 18, 2020**.
