REGARDING PROPOSED CHANGES TO CALIFORNIA REFERENCED STANDARDS CODE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PART 12 2018 TRIENNIAL RULEMAKING CYCLE

The Office of the State Fire Marshal (SFM) proposes to maintain the Standards contained in Part 12 the California Referenced Standards Code for the 2019 edition of the California Referenced Standards Code with the following modification.

Chapters 12-13 Standards for Insulating Material

QUALITY STANDARDS

Sec. 12- 13-1553. The manufacturer shall cause the testing of samples of insulating material for conformity with the quality standards described in this section.

(k) Polystyrene in Board Form.

3. A. Resistance to combustion. The material shall be tested to meet the requirements of Sections 2602.1-2602.6 2603.2 and 2603.3 of the 1994 Uniform Building Code California Building Code, with the additional provision that the surface-burning characteristics shall be determined according to ANSI/ASTM E 84- 79 and shall not exceed the following values:

Exception: Foam plastic insulation, of a thickness no greater than 2-inch nominal, installed in the horizontal portions of frost protected shallow foundations in accordance with CRC Section R403.3, CBC Section 1809.5.2, or hydronic heated slab floors on grade in accordance with CEC Section 110.8. Polystyrene foam insulation boards manufactured with no fire retardants shall be labeled in accordance with CBC Section 2603.2.1.
