- "11B-250.1 General. Circulation paths shall be physically separated from vehicular traffic. Vehicular traffic includes travel through parking facilities, into and out of parking spaces, into and out of electric vehicle charging spaces, along drives, and roadways. Physical separation shall be provided with raised circulation paths. In parking facilities, flush transitions shall not be permitted between circulation paths and parking stalls, electric vehicle charging stations, or non-accessible passenger drop-off and loading zones."
- 1. For new construction consider the same criteria for circulation path crossing accessible parking stalls, large parking lots contain long bats of accessible parking space, and only the transition to the access aisles shall be flushed as included in the language provide by exception 1.
