

**COMBINED NOTICE OF 45-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR

The California Building Standards Commission (CBSC), on behalf of the Division of the State Architect, Department of Housing and Community Development, and the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development, is providing notice of code changes intended for the 2019 California Building Standards Code.
