

**NOTICE OF 45-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR

The California Building Standards Commission (CBSC), on its own behalf and that of the Division of the State Architect, Department of Housing & Community Development, Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development, and the Office of the State Fire Marshal, is providing notice of code changes intended for the 2022 California Building Standards Code Supplement.
