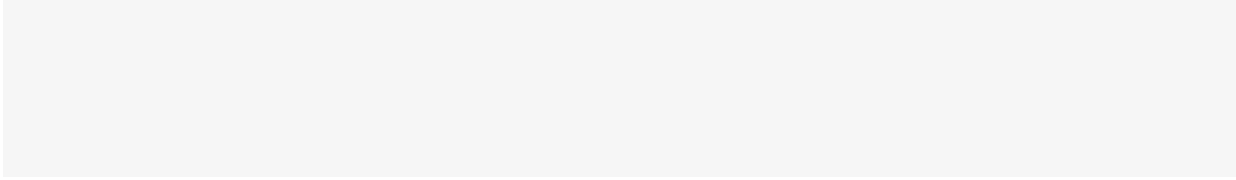
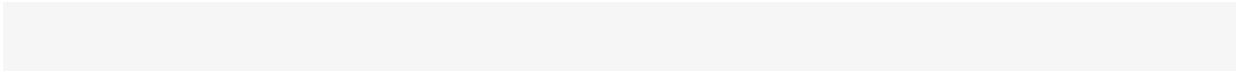

Hello,

We have serious concerns about the new regulations that you are considering and the impact it will have on not just our business, but the childcare industry as a whole in California.

I urge the Commission to create much more specific classification for different childcare facilities. The current ones feel unclear and leaves us unsure about where our school will fall under the new regulations.

Most importantly, I don't think this Commission has considered just how large an impact these regulations will have on childcare facilities. Most of our facilities occupy buildings that were not intended for childcare. The cost of retrofitting these buildings is not within the budget of most childcare facilities. Furthermore, the hardship of having to temporarily close all or part of a facility while construction occurs would force many parents to stay home from work, which extends this hardship from the schools, to their employees, the parents of the children enrolled and even the employers of those parents. Now, multiply that by the number of childcare facilities affected by these new regulations, and you have statewide impacts beyond what I believe is practical.
