Hello,

I'm writing in concern of the possibility of requiring our preschool to put in a sprinkler system. We are in an older church facility that is all one level with doors giving us emergency exits. We service roughly 70 families in 6 classrooms, ranging from age 2-6 years old. A retrofit of this scale would not be possible for our facility and could lead to us closing our over 60 year old school that has been an essential pillar to our community. I could see this being a realistic requirement for new buildings but again, it would be very difficult for older, smaller schools to put this requirement into place.
