Agenda Item 7 – The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD EF 01/18) Emergency Building Standards Readoption: The Commission adopted and approved emergency building standards at its April 17, 2018 meeting. The emergency building standards provided a consistent standard by which local agencies may develop emergency housing or shelter ordinances and provide a minimum set of building standards for compliance. The approved emergency building standards affect the 2016 edition of the California Building Code, Part 2 and California Residential Code, Part 2.5 of Title 24, California Code of Regulations. The Department of Housing and Community Development is requesting a readoption of these emergency building standards for a 90-day period pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.1(h) so they may complete the certifying rulemaking process to make the regulations permanent.
