5.106.4 Bicycle Parking

Statement of specific purpose, problem, rationale and benefits:

CBSC is proposing language to address long-term bicycle parking by:

- Clarifying that the requirement is triggered when you have new buildings with tenant spaces that have 10 or more tenant-occupants occupying an individual tenant space.
- Separating the requirements for new buildings and additions or alterations into distinct paragraphs to add clarity for application. Additionally,
- Adding a new section for new shell buildings in phased projects. This amendment will add clarity for the code user and local enforcing agencies.

SECTION 5.106 SITE DEVELOPMENT

5.106.4 Bicycle parking.

For buildings within the ...

5.106.4.1 Bicycle parking.

Comply with Sections 5.106.4.1.1 and 5.106.4.1.2; or meet the applicable local ordinance, whichever is stricter.

5.106.4.1.1 Short-term bicycle parking.

...

5.106.4.1.2 Long-term bicycle parking.

For new buildings with <u>tenant spaces that have</u> 10 or more tenant-occupants or for additions or for alterations that add 10 or more tenant vehicular parking spaces, provide secure bicycle parking for 5 percent of the tenant-occupant vehicular parking spaces. being added, with a minimum of one <u>bicycle parking facility space</u>.

5.106.4.1.3 For additions or alterations that add 10 or more tenant-occupant vehicular parking spaces, provide secure bicycle parking for 5 percent of the tenant vehicular parking spaces being added, with a minimum of one bicycle parking facility.

5.106.4.1.4 For new shell buildings in phased projects provide secure bicycle parking for 5 percent of the anticipated tenant-occupant vehicular parking spaces with a minimum of one bicycle parking facility.

[Paragraph below was relocated from Section 5.106.4.1.2 with additional edits]

<u>The acceptable bicycle parking facilityies for Sections 5.106.4.1.2, 5.106.4.1.3 & 5.106.4.1.4</u> shall be convenient from the street and shall meet one of the following:

- 1. Covered, lockable enclosures with permanently anchored racks for bicycles;
- 2. Lockable bicycle rooms with permanently anchored racks; or
- 3. Lockable, permanently anchored bicycle lockers.
