

**CALIFORNIA BUILDING STANDARDS COMMISSION
EXTERIOR ELEVATED ELEMENTS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS
CERTIFYING RULEMAKING TIMELINE**

California Building Standards Code, Title 24, California Code of Regulations (Title 24) emergency regulations are proposed and adopted pursuant to California Building Standards Law Health and Safety Code, Division 13, Part 2.5, Sections 18901 - 18949.31, and Government Code 11346.1 - 11347.3.

Emergency regulations shall remain in effect no more than 180 days unless the adopting agency has certified and complied with Government Code Sections 11346.2 to 11347.3 within the 180-day period. Emergency regulations may twice be readopted, each for a period not to exceed 90 days, pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.1.

Title 24 Emergency Regulation readoption

The Exterior Elevated Elements (EEE) emergency regulations first went into effect Jan. 30, 2017 and expire July 29, 2017.

- June 20, 2017 Commission meeting ~ Each State agency must request a 90 day readoption. The emergencies will remain in effect until Oct. 27, 2017.
- October 17, 2017 Commission meeting ~ Each State agency must request its second 90 day readoption. The emergencies will remain in effect until Jan. 26, 2018.
- December 12, 2017 Commission meeting ~ Each State agency presents its final certifying rulemaking package to make the emergencies permanent in the 2016 edition of Title 24.

Title 24 Certifying Rulemaking schedule *[Dates are subject to change]*

- August 7, 2017 ~ State agencies submit 45-day comment period rulemaking submittal to the California Building Standard Commission (CBSC)
- September 1 – Oct. 16 ~ 45 day public comment period
 - September – October ~ the 2018 International Building Code and International Existing Building Code will be released which may necessitate the California emergency regulations be modified.
- October 25 – Nov. 10 ~ 15 day public comment period, if necessary
- November 15 ~ Final rulemaking submittal due to BSC
- Dec. 12, 2017 ~ Commission takes action on the rulemakings
