The Act generally requires CCDA to publicly notice their meetings, prepare agendas, accept public testimony, and conduct their meetings in public unless specifically authorized by the Act to meet in closed session.
- Meetings are subject to cancellation; agenda items are subject to removal or items may be taken out of order.
- The Commission meets under the authority of Government Code §14985.
- ❖ The Commission may hold a closed session on pending or proposed litigation involving the Commission [Govt. Code §11126(e)] and personnel matters and performance review relating to the Commission [Govt. Code §11126(a)].

- Using Zoom via Mobile Device
  - 1. Click on the three sideways dots, labeled "More." The "More" option is in the toolbar on the bottom right corner of the screen.
  - 2. After clicking "More" a new window will pop-up at the bottom of your screen
  - 3. Press "Raise Hand.
