- ❖ CCDA meetings are operating under the requirements of the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act set forth in Government Code Section §11120-11132. The Act generally requires CCDA to publicly notice their meetings, prepare agendas, accept public testimony, and conduct their meetings in public unless specifically authorized by the Act to meet in closed session.
- ❖ Public comment on matters not on the agenda is taken at the beginning of the meeting. Public comment on matters on the agenda will be heard as the Commission takes up agenda items for discussion. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes. Speakers who utilize translators to make public comment will be allotted no more than six (6) minutes unless they utilize simultaneous translation equipment. CCDA is precluded from discussing matters not on the agenda; however, CCDA members may ask questions for clarification purposes.
- ❖ Meetings are subject to cancellation; agenda items are subject to removal or items may be taken out of order.
- ❖ The Commission meets under the authority of Government Code §14985.
- ❖ The Commission may hold a closed session on pending or proposed litigation involving the Commission [Govt. Code §11126(e)] and personnel matters and performance review relating to the Commission [Govt. Code §11126(a)].
- ❖ The meeting facilities and restrooms are accessible to individuals with disabilities.
- ❖ Each Commission meeting will provide a teleconference line, large print agendas, and captioning.
- ❖ Requests for accommodations for individuals with disabilities (sign-language interpreter, assistive listening device, Braille, or any other accommodation needed by an individual) should be made to the Commission no later than five (5) working days prior to the day of the meeting.
