I. CCDA Vice Chair

As outlined in [California Government Code Section 14985.2](#), the commission shall select annually from its membership a chairperson who shall be a representative from the disability community, and a vice chairperson who shall be a representative from the business community.

II. CCDA Legislative Committee Chair

The CCDA Legislative Committee Chair leads the CCDA Legislative Committee, a standing committee established pursuant to Section 8 (Standing, AD Hoc, and Sub-Committees) of the CCDA Bylaws.

As outlined in the bylaws, standing committees are a permanent part of the organization and perform functions essential to the operation of the CCDA. The Legislative Committee was created to discuss disability access-related legislation and policy matters in an advisory capacity to the Commission. The Legislative Committee Chair works in coordination with the CCDA Chair and Executive Director to ensure that committee activities align with the Commission's mandate and priorities.
