

Agenda Item 4: CCDA's New Legislative Committee Members

I. CCDA Legislative Committee

The CCDA Legislative Committee Chair leads the CCDA Committee, a standing committee established pursuant to Section 8 (Standing, AD Hoc, and Sub-Committees) of the CCDA Bylaws.

As outlined in the bylaws, standing committees are a permanent part of the organization and perform functions essential to the operation of the CCDA. The Legislative Committee was created to discuss disability access related legislation and policy matters. It functions as an advisory body, offering recommendations to its parent/decision-making body, the Commission. The Legislative Chair works in coordination with the CCDA Chair and Executive Director to ensure that committee activities align with the Commission's mandate and priorities.

Additional public stakeholders may be appointed to serve on and vote on a standing committee or ad hoc committee, subject to the approval of the CCDA chair in consultation with the chair of the standing committee or ad hoc committee and the Executive Director.
