U.S. Department of Justice Recommendations for Elements to Include in Self-Evaluation Review

- A review of policies that may limit exclude the participation of qualified persons with disabilities;
- Review of communication systems;
- Review of the provision of auxiliary aids and services the members of the public;
- Emergency management for persons with disabilities;
- Review to determine whether publications and interactions with persons with disabilities are conducted in a respectful manner;
- Review of services provided through bona fide historic sites;
- Review of policy modification procedures;
- Review of access to public meetings;
- Review employment policies and practices;
- Review of construction policies;
- Review of guidance and training provided to staff; and
- Review of ADA related drug policies.
