



# STATE FLEET VEHICLE COMPOSITION REPORT FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2016-2018

**SB 552 AND AB 236** 

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### Overview

In 2003, Senate Bill (SB) 552 (Burton, Chapter 737, Statutes of 2003) added Public Resources Code (PRC) §25722.5,¹ which enacted requirements on the state fleet to increase fuel efficiency through the adoption of smaller alternatively fueled vehicles. In addition to SB 552, Assembly Bill (AB) 236 (Lieu, Chapter 593, Statutes of 2007) modified PRC §25722.5 to impose additional state fleet reporting requirements on the Department of General Services (DGS). Specifically, AB 236 imposed reporting requirements related to the state fleet's fuel use, access to alternative fuel stations, and total annual vehicle miles traveled. As part of the statutory requirements, DGS must provide information every three years to the Legislature and Governor on the nature of the vehicles that are owned or leased by the state. This report covers the three-year period from 2016 to 2018.

From 2016 to 2018, the number of total passenger vehicles in the state fleet increased by approximately 3 percent. Of the sub-categories outlined in SB 552, alternative fuel vehicles (AFVs) decreased by 2 percent, hybrid electric vehicles increased by 27 percent, and all other passenger vehicles increased by 4 percent. While the number of AFVs in the state fleet decreased over the three-year period, zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs), which for the purposes of this report are classified as AFVs, increased from 429 to 834, representing an increase of 94 percent. This demonstrates a deliberate shift to more efficient and less polluting types of AFVs.

To support the rapid adoption of AFVs, the state uses a network of private and public charging and fueling stations throughout the state. From 2016 to 2018, California has experienced a large increase in alternative fueling stations that are accessible to state fleet vehicles. In 2016, there were 1,087 alternative fuel (E85, CNG, electricity, biodiesel, ethanol, hydrogen, LNG, and propane) stations that had been reported as open. In 2018, that number had increased by 78 percent to 1,930 stations. Additionally, as of 2018, there were another 3,661 publicly available alternative fueling stations that were active but did not report an "open" date. Of the 5,591 active stations in 2018, 92 percent were reported as EV charging stations. It is clear from this report that the installation of EV charging infrastructure is the main driving force behind the increased number of publicly available alternative fuel stations.

As the public availability of alternative fueling stations has grown, so has the use of alternative fuels in the state fleet. From 2016 to 2017, the increased usage of alternative fuels outpaced growth in the usage of petroleum based fuels by 2 percent. The state fleet increased its consumption of alternative fuels by 6 percent, while over the same time period also increasing consumption of petroleum based fuel by 4 percent. Within the alternative fuel category, electricity consumption nearly doubled from 2016 to 2017 with an increase of 75 percent, and hydrogen jumped from zero consumption in 2016 to 2,868 gallons in 2017. From 2016 to 2018, the state fleet reduced its vehicle miles traveled (VMT) each year for a total VMT reduction of 43,756,701 miles. The total number of state fleet miles accumulated over the same time period was 1,136,594,370.

### **Reporting Requirements**

SB 552 mandated that the Department of General Services (DGS) report to the Legislature and the governor, beginning on July 1, 2009, and every three years thereafter, the information on the nature of vehicles that are owned or leased by the state. It also mandated that DGS shall make that information available, as soon as practicable, to the public. This report covers the three year reporting period of 2016 through 2018. The following vehicle information is made available in this report:

- 1. The number of passenger-type motor vehicles purchased or leased during the year, and the number owned or leased as of December 31 of each year.
- 2. The number of sport utility vehicles (SUVs) and four-wheel drive trucks purchased or leased by the state during the year, and the number owned or leased as of December 31 of each year.
- 3. The number of alternatively fueled vehicles and hybrid vehicles purchased or leased by the state during the year, and the total number owned or leased as of December 31 of each year.
- 4. The justification provided for all SUVs and four-wheel drive trucks purchased or leased by the state, and the specific office, department, or agency responsible for the purchase or lease.
- 5. The number of SUVs and four-wheel drive trucks purchased or leased by the state during the year, and the number owned or leased as of December 31 of each year, that are alternative fuel or hybrid vehicles.
- 6. The number of (nonessential) light-duty trucks disposed of.
- 7. The total dollars spent by the state on passenger-type vehicle purchases and leases, categorized by SUV and non-SUV, and within each of those categories, by alternative fuel, hybrid and other.

In addition to SB 552, Assembly Bill (AB) 236 (Lieu, Chapter 593, Statutes of 2007) modified PRC §25722.5 to impose additional state fleet reporting requirements on DGS. Those reporting requirements are as follows:

- 1. The locations of the alternative fuel pumps available for alternatively fueled vehicles.
- 2. The total annual consumption of gasoline and diesel fuel used by the state fleet.
- 3. The total annual consumption of alternative fuels.
- 4. On December 31, 2009, and annually thereafter, compile the total annual vehicle miles traveled by vehicles in the state fleet.

## **Reporting Data**

PRC §25722.5 requires all passenger vehicles purchased or leased by state executive branch agencies to be reported annually by DGS. Although all of the vehicles reported are technically "passenger vehicles," we have subdivided the vehicles into one of the following three types in Attachments A through D: regular (sedans), sport utility vehicles (SUVs) or 4x4 trucks. This report does not include equipment types such as construction equipment, tractors, trailers, forklifts, boats and golf carts, nor data for vehicles belonging to the state's legislative or judicial branches, the University of California, the California

State University, District Agricultural Associations, or state agencies that do not own or lease vehicles.

DGS worked extensively with executive branch agencies to collect, verify and report vehicle data for calendar years 2016 through 2018. Executive branch agencies are required to upload information on assets that are self-propelled or registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles into the Fleet Asset Management System data warehouse, which allows DGS to electronically generate this report. However, due to the manual process of initial data collection and reporting, some data discrepancies or gaps existed in the initial data set. DGS accounted for those data discrepancies and gaps by removing outlier data and filling of gaps through trending calculations. While DGS works extensively to ensure the data uploaded in to the system and used in this report is accurate and complete, minimal discrepancies may remain.

### **SB 552 Vehicle Composition Reporting**

DGS has added a summary and overview of the vehicle acquisition data reported by state agencies to highlight key points and purchasing and composition trends of the state's fleet. Attachments A through D are the primary reporting instruments to fulfill the requirements of SB 552 and AB 236 for calendar years 2016 through 2018. The attachments provide detailed information by department for each of the required vehicle and fuel types and disposed vehicles. The chart below (Illustration 1) shows a detailed, year-by-year report of overall purchases, leases and disposals made by state agencies:

From 2016 to 2018, the total number of vehicles in the state fleet increased by 3 percent, while the total number of alternative fuel and hybrid vehicles grew at a slightly slower pace of 2 percent. Of the designated vehicle categories on which SB 552 requires reporting, hybrid electric vehicles experienced the largest increase in the state fleet, with a 27 percent increase over the three-year period. Also, it is important to note that for the purposes of this report, zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) such as battery electric, plug-in hybrid, and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles are categorized as alternative fuel vehicles (AFVs) along with traditional alternative fuel vehicles such as flex fuel ethanol and compressed natural gas vehicles. Consequently, while we have only seen a 2 percent increase in the number of designated AFVs over the three-year period, the state fleet has experienced a significant shift to more efficient and less polluting types of vehicles within the category. Within the AFV category, from 2016 to 2018, the number of ZEVs in the state fleet increased from 429 to 834, representing an increase of 94 percent.

The vehicle type composition of the fleet inventory has remained largely stable. Passenger vehicles increased by 2 percent, SUVs increased by 3 percent, and four-wheel drive vehicles increased by 6 percent. In 2018, 70 percent of the fleet was comprised of regular passenger vehicles, 12 percent was comprised of SUVs, and 18 percent was comprised of four-wheel drive trucks. It is important to note that the category of regular passenger vehicles is not solely comprised of sedans; the category also includes all two-wheel drive trucks and vans.

### **AB 236 Reporting Requirements**

### **Alternative Fuel Station Locations**

In order to comply with AB 236's requirement to collect the locations of alternative fuel pumps available for alternatively fueled vehicles, DGS uses the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Alternative Fuels Data Center's Alternative Fuel Station Locator to collect data on all alternative fuel stations in California (a copy of the report has been included for reference). Based on a report generated by the Alternative Fuel Station Locator, as of 2018 in California,

there were 5,591 publicly available alternative fuel stations that the state fleet could access. Of the 5,591 alternative fuel stations, only 1,930 had registered "open dates"; however, all 5,591 stations were confirmed as being active within the previous year. The composition of the 5,591 active alternative fueling stations is as follows:

- 5,150 electric charging stations
- 167 compressed natural gas fueling stations
- 143 ethanol (E85) fueling stations
- 64 liquefied petroleum gas (propane) fueling stations
- 39 hydrogen fueling stations
- 18 liquefied natural gas fueling stations
- 10 biodiesel fueling stations

### State Fleet Petroleum Consumption

To comply with the annual fuel reporting requirements of PRC §25722.5, DGS posts annual conventional and alternative fuel consumption numbers on its Green Fleet website.<sup>2</sup> Due to fuel reporting being a manual process that requires a significant amount of time to collect and validate fuel consumption totals, the most recent year for which DGS has fuel consumption data available on the website is 2017. From 2016 to 2017, consumption of gasoline and diesel fuel increased by 4 percent, for a total increase of 1,315,659 gallons. Over the same period, the use of alternative fuels grew by 6 percent, for a total increase of 261,455 gallons. The increase in petroleum fuel consumption is primarily the result of increased usage by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CalFire). From 2016 to 2017, CalFire's consumption of gasoline and diesel fuel increased from 3,181,254 gallons to 4,857,701 gallons. Much of this increase is due to more fire response activity and additional forest clearing efforts. Figures 1 and 2 below show state fleet fuel consumption by fuel type for 2016 and 2017. Once data is available for 2018, the fuel consumption figures will be posted on the Green Fleet website.

AB 236 requires the reporting of total annual vehicle miles traveled. The total number of department vehicle miles accumulated between years 2016 to 2018 was: 1,136,594,370. The annual miles driven were as follows:

- 395,797,028 in 2016
- 388,757,015 in 2017
- 352,040,327 in 2018

DGS will publish reports every three years including the collection of data as required by the statute. The next report will cover the years 2019, 2020 and 2021.
