Executive Summary

This report is required by Business and Professions Code Section 312.1, effective Jan. 1, 2015. Business and Professions Code Section 312.1 directs the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) to provide specified case-related data yearly to the Governor, the Legislature, and the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA), commencing Jan. 1, 2016. This is the eighth annual report, and it contains data for the 2021-22 fiscal year.

Measures Reported

Business and Professions Code Section 312.1 requires OAH to provide the following case-related data for the previous fiscal year:

- A.) Number of cases referred by each constituent entity to each office of OAH for a hearing.
- B.) Average number of days from receiving a request to setting a hearing date at each office of OAH.
- C.) Average number of days from setting a hearing to conducting the hearing.
- D.) Average number of days after conducting a hearing to transmitting the proposed decision by each office of OAH.

Analysis

Along with the required data, this report also contains a summary of three fiscal years' data and a comparison to the last fiscal year's report. This comparison data assists in identifying areas where improvement has been made and areas where additional improvement is needed.

For fiscal year 2021-22, DCA filings with OAH were reduced **14 percent** from the previous year. Average case-setting times increased by **33 percent** (an increase of one day) over the previous year. The average time from setting a hearing to conducting the hearing decreased slightly (**19 percent**) over the previous year. There was also a slight decrease of **4 percent** in the average number of days from a matter being submitted for decision to the date of decision issuance (**25** days). This number remains well below the target of 30 days.

Report Detail

Business and Professions Code Section 312.1, subdivision (a)

Table A provides the number of cases referred to each OAH office by each DCA agency. Any DCA agencies that did not refer any cases to OAH during the 2021-22 fiscal year are not listed. DCA agencies¹ are in rows. OAH offices are in columns. The final column represents the total cases for all OAH offices. The final row totals each column.

During the 2021-22 fiscal year, OAH received a total of **2,305** cases, a decrease of **14 percent** compared to the prior fiscal year.

The final column shows the overall OAH average. The final row shows the overall average for each column. For OAH statewide, the average number of days taken to set a case for hearing after receiving a request to set a hearing date has increased by **33 percent** (an increase of one day) over the prior fiscal year.

Statewide, the average number of days after conducting a hearing to transmitting the proposed decision slightly decreased to **25** days. This average remains well below the 30-day target.
