- <u>DSA 103: List of Required Structural Tests and Special Inspections User Guide</u> This guide was revised to provide a step-by-step process on how to access the DSA 103 Web Forms and set up your account for registration. (Revised 04/07/25)

- <u>IR A-4: Geohazard Report Requirements: 2022 CBC</u> This IR was updated to clarify the report requirements concerning when a report is required to be prepared, when the report must be reviewed and accepted by the California Geological Survey (CGS), what information must be included in the report, how geological hazard zones are defined and how soil improvement work is approved. (Revised 05/02/25)
- <u>DSA 175: Project Inspector Examination Application</u> This form was revised to improve organization and usability. (Revised 05/14/25)

• <u>IR 19-8: Shotcrete Construction: 2022 CBC</u> This new IR clarifies requirements to qualify concrete construction placed by the shotcrete method on projects under DSA jurisdiction. This includes requirements of the construction documents, preconstruction demonstration, and quality assurance during construction. (Issued 05/22/25)

 <u>IR 17-1: Special Inspection Program (SIP)</u> This IR was revised Section 3.6.5 to clarify requirements for a competency evaluation procedure in a laboratory's Quality Management System (QMS). (Revised 06/26/25)

DSA 108: Change in Delegation of Responsibility and Instructions Update

The form <u>DSA 108: Change in Delegation of Responsibility and Instructions</u> was revised with changes as follows:

- Extended form DSA 108 applicability to forms DSA 1-DEL: Delegation of Responsibility, DSA 1-MR: Application for New Manufactured Permanent Modular or Relocatable Buildings, and prior submitted DSA 108 in Section 2.
- Revised the Authorized Agent listed on Section 8 to General Responsible Charge.

IR EB Series Update

Editorial and organizational changes have been made to improve the readability and clarity of the documents. Other revisions have been implemented to improve understanding and communication as guided by feedback received from users of the documents. These changes are identified with margin markings in accordance with DSA standards.

DSA 103-19 and DSA 103-22 Update

The following changes to the forms <u>DSA 103-19</u>: List of Required Structural Tests and Special Inspections – 2019 CBC and <u>DSA 103-22</u>: List of Required Structural Tests and Special Inspections – 2022 CBC (Revised 06/20/25) will include:

- Adding "Concrete Batch Plant Inspection : Form 291" to the list of required verified reports when "Periodic" Batch Plant Inspection is selected at C1e and M1f.
- Adding a check box to the masonry veneer section (M2) to identify a "Project with adhered veneer only" resulting in M2.c and M2.d becoming unselected.

For the 2022 version, C3.a modified the PCI MNL-117 and NPCA versions in the "Code Refences and Notes."

DSA 3 and 403 Update

The Division of the State Architect (DSA) has updated forms <u>DSA 3: Project Submittal Checklist</u> and <u>DSA</u> <u>403: Energy Code Compliance Checklist</u>, which may be found on the DSA <u>Forms</u> webpage. As of the date of this posting, all projects are required to submit the revised DSA 3 with project documentation.

This update added space to input DSA Application Number and the date of form DSA 3 completion; revised Over-The-Counter drawings sets requirement; added California climate zone, locations of fire apparatus access roadways, and form *DSA 1-AMM-PV: Request for Alternate Design, Materials and Methods of Construction* to the checklist; and various clarification items throughout the checklist.
