ORDER SPECIFYING COSTS SHIFTED

APRIL 17, 2023

On April 5, 2023, OAH issued an Order Shifting Costs for Attorney Misconduct in this matter that shifted costs incurred by Yuba City to Attorney Sheila Bayne. The reasons for that Order and the procedural history that led to it are set forth in the Order and need not be repeated here.

On April 11, 2023, Yuba City filed a response to the Order Shifting Costs, accompanied by the declarations of attorneys Dee Anna Hassanpour and Anisha Asher. OAH has received no response to Yuba City's cost statement from Student.

Yuba City's response and accompanying declarations establish that it incurred \$968 in costs due to the misconduct described in the Order Shifting Costs. Each attorney states her hourly rate and sets forth separately the amount of time she spent on each phase of the pleadings Yuba City was required to file, and on appearances at the prehearing conference on March 27, 2023. OAH has examined this statement of costs and finds the expenditures it describes reasonable in all respects.

ORDER

1. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, attorney Sheila C. Bayne shall pay \$968 to Yuba City, through its attorneys, to defray the costs of litigation occasioned by her misconduct.
2. Attorney Bayne shall pay the above amount personally and not pass the cost to a client.
3. Within 35 days of the date of this order, Yuba City shall file with OAH a statement showing whether the full amount assessed has been properly paid.
