ORDER FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE AND GRANTING
CONTINUANCE

On January 23, 2013, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) June R. Lehrman, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Guy Leemhuis, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Daniel Harbottle, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of District. The PHC was recorded.

At the outset of the PHC, both counsel stated their stipulation to a continuance to agreed-upon dates in March. This is the parties' first request for a continuance of the PHC and hearing. Good cause appearing, the hearing is continued and all current dates are vacated. The new dates shall be as follows:

PHC: March 4, 2013, at 1:30 p.m.¹ (OAH will initiate the call.) PHC statements shall be filed and served three days prior to the PHC.

Due Process Hearing: March 13 and 14, 2013 at 9:30 a.m. each day.
