ORDER SETTING STATUS
CONFERENCE AND CONTINUING
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On February 12, 2013, the third day of the due process hearing convened as scheduled. Justin R. Shinnefield, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Poway Unified School District (District) and Mother appeared on behalf of Student.

Mother reported she had a serious health issue and was awaiting word from her doctor. After some discussion, Administrative Law Judge, Clifford H. Woosley, continued the hearing to the afternoon, allowing Mother an opportunity to see her health provider.

Mother reported at 3:00 p.m., February 12, 2012, that she was unable to proceed with the hearing and she required a number of days to have her health issues addressed. The parties are ordered to appear at a telephonic status conference at 2:00 p.m., February 19, 2013, at which time Mother will provide a status report regarding her health and ability to proceed.

OAH requires that a due process proceeding have assigned hearing dates, at all times. Accordingly, the hearing is continued to March 11, 12, 13, and 14, 2013, at the District's offices located at 15250 Avenue of Science, San Diego, CA 92128. The hearing shall begin at 11:00 a.m. on March 11, 2013 and at 9:00 a.m. for all other days, unless otherwise ordered. Mother or Mr. Shinnefield can discuss, if necessary, the continued hearing dates at the February 19, 2013 status conference.
