ORDER VACATING HEARING
DATES AND SETTING TELEPHONIC
STATUS CONFERENCE

Hearing in this matter is set to begin on February 11, 2013, in Santa Barbara, California, before Administrative Law Judge Deidre L. Johnson (ALJ), Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). On February 7, 2013, Student notified OAH that the parties have executed a written settlement agreement subject to approval of the school board. Student requested a continuance until February 27, 2013, for a conference on the status of that approval. District confirmed its joinder in the request.

Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f).) Where a settlement agreement is pending board approval, the case will not be dropped from the calendar but may be continued to a status conference. Good cause has been established and the request for a continuance is:
