ORDER FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE

On March 18, 2013, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) June R. Lehrman, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Deborah Pepaj, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. South Pasadena Unified School District did not appear. The PHC was recorded.

Ms. Pepaj stated on the record her understanding that District was to be represented by counsel, and that the parties had orally agreed upon a continuance.

In order to enable District to file a Notice of Representation, and to permit the parties to make a formal continuance request, the ALJ was prepared to continue the PHC to March 20, 2013, at 10:00 AM. However, because a joint request for continuance was processed and ruled on by the Presiding ALJ after the telephonic PHC, all dates are controlled by the Presiding ALJ's continuance order.

Any peremptory challenge to the undersigned will be considered untimely because the PHC went forward as scheduled.
