AMENDED ORDER GRANTING
REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND
SETTING MEDIATION, PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND DUE PROCESS
HEARING

Counsel for the Del Mar Union School District has requested that the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) revise a continuance order issued on September 16, 2013, to show that the hearing date is Monday, October 21, 2013, instead of October 22 and 23, 2013. The parties are hereby informed that, normally, OAH begins hearings that fall on a Monday at 1:30 p.m., in order to allow for the possibility that an out-of-town judge can arrive at the hearing in a timely manner. The District's request will be granted, but, in the event that OAH must assign an Administrative Law Judge from the Van Nuys or Sacramento offices to hear this matter, the due process hearing in the case will start at 1:30 p.m., meaning that the parties will not be able to finish the matter in a single day.

Pursuant to the previously filed request for continuance, this matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference:	10/18/2013, at 10:00 a.m.
Due Process Hearing:	10/21/2013, at 9:30 a.m., and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
