ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE OF OCTOBER 28, 2013;
ORDER TRAILING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE TO NOVEMBER 1,
2013 AT 10:00 A.M.

On October 28, 2013, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Darrell Lepkowsky, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Hans Gillinger, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Chris Fernandez, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Manhattan Beach Unified School District (District). Jennifer Williams, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE). The ALJ recorded the PHC.

On September 27, 2013, OAH granted the parties' request for a continuance of approximately one month based upon their representation that the parties had settled this matter and needed to memorialize the agreement in a written document. At today's prehearing conference, the parties indicated that the settlement agreement had been signed by all but the authorized representative from LACOE. Counsel for LACOE informed that she had already signed the agreement and anticipated that LACOE's authorized representative would sign the agreement by the close of business today.

Based upon the parties' representations, and good cause having been shown, the prehearing conference in this matter is trailed to **November 1, 2013, at 10:00 a.m.** Should the parties finalize their settlement agreement before then, Counsel for Student is directed to

file the appropriate documents with OAH in support of the executed settlement, along with a request to vacate the PHC and hearing dates. Counsel for Student should provide OAH at that time with the date that the District's School Board is anticipated to consider the settlement agreement for Board approval. OAH will then vacate the PHC set for November 1, 2013, as well as the hearing dates, and will calendar a status conference for a time subsequent to the meeting of the District's Board. If the appropriate documents are not filed with OAH prior to November 1, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., the PHC will proceed as scheduled.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
