ORDER FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE AND CONTINUING
PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE AND
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On November 8, 2013, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was commenced before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Robert G. Martin, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Patrick Balucan, Esq. appeared on behalf of petitioner Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD). Parent's father (Parent) appeared on behalf of Student. The PHC was recorded.

Neither party filed a PHC Statement in this matter. At the commencement of the PHC, the parties jointly requested that OAH continue the PHC and due process hearing dates in this matter to give the parties time to complete the drafting of a settlement agreement negotiated by the parties. A due process hearing must be held, and a decision rendered, within 45 days of receipt of the complaint, unless a continuance is granted for good cause. (Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f) & 56505, subd. (f)(1)(C)(3).) Here, good cause was shown for a continuance to allow the parties to complete a settlement of this matter. The matter was filed recently on October 24, 2013, and the parties have not previously requested any continuances.

On joint motion of the parties, the PHC is continued for completion, and the Due Process Hearing continued, as follows: Completion of Telephonic PHC: December 6, 2013 at 1:00 p.m.; Due Process Hearing: December 17, 2013 at the Office of Administrative Hearings, 15350 Sherman Way, Van Nuys, CA 91406, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the ALJ.

Each party shall file and serve a PHC Statement no later than three business days prior to the continued PHC.
