ORDER FOLLOWING AND
CONTINUING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On November 8, 2013, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Sheila L. Brogna, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Jennifer A. Stalzer, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the San Mateo Union High School District (District). Timothy J. Fox, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the San Mateo County Office of Education (SMCOE). The PHC was recorded.

At the outset of the PHC, the parties represented that they had reached a settlement of the matter; that most of the required signatures to a written settlement agreement had been obtained and the others were expected shortly; and that when all signatures have been obtained the matter will be dismissed. Since the parties wish to avoid the time and expense of a PHC, Student moved to continue the PHC, and the other parties had no objection.

Good cause appearing, the PHC is continued until November 18, 2013, at 1 p.m. If the matter has not been dismissed by the close of business on November 15, 2013, all parties shall file PHC statements by that time if they have not already done so. The due process hearing shall remain on calendar as now set, and shall begin on November 19, 2013, at 9:30 a.m., unless otherwise ordered.
