ORDER FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE AND CONTINUING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND
DUE PROCESS HEARING DATES

On November 22, 2013, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Laurie Gorsline, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Karen Gilyard, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Wiseburn School District. Parent did not appear. The PHC was recorded.

Based on the Request for Continuance signed by the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

1. Hearing Dates, Times, and Location. The hearing is continued on joint motion of the parties and shall take place December 16 through 19, 2013 and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday as needed at the discretion of the ALJ. The hearing shall begin each day at 9:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m. with the exception of the first day of hearing, on which day the hearing shall begin at 1:30 p.m.

The hearing shall take place at the District's offices located at Wiseburn Elementary School District, 13530 Aviation Blvd., Hawthorne, CA 90250.

The parties shall immediately notify all potential witnesses of the hearing dates, and shall subpoena witnesses if necessary, to ensure that the witnesses will be available to testify. A witness will not be regarded as unavailable for purposes of showing "good cause" to continue the hearing if the witness is not properly notified of the hearing date or properly subpoenaed, as applicable.

2. Continued PHC. The telephonic PHC is continued to December 9, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. OAH will initiate the conference call.

3. Settlement. The parties are encouraged to continue working together to reach an agreement before the due process hearing. The parties shall inform OAH in writing immediately should they reach a settlement or otherwise resolve the dispute before the scheduled hearing. In addition, if a settlement is reached within five days of the

scheduled start of the due process hearing, the parties shall also inform OAH of the settlement by telephone at (916) 263-0880.
