ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND CONTINUANCE
OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On July 28, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was scheduled to be heard before Administrative Law Judge Peter Paul Castillo, Office of Administrative Hearings. ALJ Castillo attempted to convene the PHC by telephoning David Tollner, legal counsel for Student, and Laura Schulkind, legal counsel for Franklin McKinley School District. Neither attorney appeared at the PHC nor filed a PHC conference statement or continuance request. The PHC conference was scheduled for July 28, 2014, in the June 23, 2014 scheduling order

Accordingly, the PHC is rescheduled to August 1, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., and OAH shall initiate the PHC. Parties are ordered to serve their PHC conference statements on opposing party and OAH no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 29, 2014. Any continuance request shall include a declaration under penalty of perjury why the continuance was not submitted before the July 28, 2014 PHC. Failure to comply with this order may result in the exclusion of evidence or other sanctions, including dismissal of the complaint.
