ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE ON EXPEDITED
HEARING, VACATING EXPEDITED
HEARING DATES AND DISMISSING
EXPEDITED ISSUES

On August 18, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Alexa J. Hohensee, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Matthew D. Engebretson, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Susan B. Winkelman, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Sierra Sands Unified School District (District). The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, the ALJ issues the following order

1. Expedited Issues Withdrawn and Expedited Hearing Dates Vacated. Both parties represented on the record that a final written agreement of all issues in this matter has been reached and executed by the parties, but Parent has not yet provided Student's counsel with a copy of the signature page with Parent's signature. Pursuant to that agreement, Student has already returned to the placement from which he was removed. In reliance upon the representation of District on the record that withdrawal of the expedited issue in this matter would not affect District's agreement to the terms of the current agreement between the parties pending receipt of Parent's signature and District board approval, Student withdrew the expedited issue in his due process hearing request.

The expedited hearing dates in this matter are vacated and the expedited issues dismissed. The dates of the non-expedited prehearing conference and due process hearing will remain on calendar until and unless one of the parties files with OAH a copy of the fully executed signature page of the final settlement agreement, with a notice of the next scheduled District board meeting and a request to vacate non-expedited dates and set a status conference.
