ORDER FOLLOWING AND
CONTINUING EXPEDITED
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On September 12, 2014, an expedited telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Kira Proehl, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Leah M. Smith, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Gilroy Unified School District (Gilroy). The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

1. Motion for Continuance. At the outset of the expedited PHC, the parties moved for a continuance of the expedited PHC on the ground that they had arrived at a tentative settlement of the matter and were anticipating making their agreement final shortly. The ALJ advised the parties that without a written withdrawal by Student of all expedited issues in the complaint, the expedited PHC and the expedited due process hearing scheduled to begin on September 16, 2014, would remain on calendar and would take place. Student's attorney then represented that she would promptly file a withdrawal of all expedited issues on Student's behalf. The parties seek to continue the expedited PHC until that withdrawal can be filed.

Good cause appearing, the expedited PHC is continued to September 15, 2014, at 1:00 p.m. All other dates remain as calendared.

2. All Other Matters Deferred to Continued PHC. All other matters are deferred to the continued expedited PHC on September 15, 2014.
