ORDER TO PROVIDE
DECLARATIONS AND SUPPORTING
EVIDENCE

On October 2, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings issued an order granting the parties' request to bifurcate issues. The issues regarding Student's residency were bifurcated from the other issues in the case and the ALJ granted the parties request to have the residency issues determined prior to the hearing on the remaining issues in this matter. The parties waived their rights to present witnesses and participate in an in-person hearing as to the residency issues and were ordered to submit a stipulated statement of facts and simultaneous written briefs and arguments. The parties timely submitted a stipulated statement of facts and written briefs and arguments. However, the parties did not attach any written declarations or documentary evidence to the stipulated facts. The parties must supply sworn declarations and/or documentary evidence to support the stipulated facts that they have submitted. At the minimum the parties must submit sworn declarations that the facts contained in the statement of stipulated facts are true and correct, and based upon personal knowledge of the parties.

ORDER

Within five days of this order, each party shall provide sworn declarations and/or documentary evidence on the issues of residency.
