ORDER FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE, GRANTING JOINT
REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND
SETTING MEDIATION, PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND HEARING

On November 14, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Clifford H. Woosley, Office of Administrative Hearings. Jack B. Clarke, Jr., Best Best & Krieger LLP, appeared on behalf of Riverside Unified School District (District). Parent appeared on behalf of Student. The PHC was recorded.

District requested due process on October 21, 2014. The scheduling order set mediation for November 12, 2014, and hearing for November 19, 2014. Parents gave timely notice that they were unable to attend the scheduled mediation, indicating they would reschedule with District. On November 12, 2014, District provided notice that it had retained counsel.

District requests a continuance of all dates. Student's parents also request a new mediation date. This is the first continuance and, during the prehearing conference, the parties agreed to the continued dates.

Good cause appearing, the request for continuance is granted. The continued mediation, prehearing conference and hearing are scheduled as follows:

Mediation:	9:30 a.m., December 11, 2014, at Riverside USD, 5700 Arlington Avenue, Conference Room A, Riverside, California 92501.
Prehearing Conference:	10 a.m., February 13, 2015 (telephonic)
Due Process Hearing:	February 24, 25, and 26, 2015, beginning at 9:00 a.m., except for the first day, which will begin at 1:30 p.m., and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge, at District's offices, 5700 Arlington Avenue,

Conference Room A, Riverside, California
92501.

Because the continued hearing dates are more than 90 days from the initially scheduled date, no further continuances are contemplated without a substantive showing of good cause.
