ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE OF JUNE 1, 2015

On June 1, 2015, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Robert Helfand, Office of Administrative Hearings. Parents appeared on behalf of themselves on behalf of Student. Mary Kellogg, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Los Angeles Unified School District. District filed its PHC Statement on May 27, 2015. Student has not filed a PHC Statement. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

Motion to Continue: Student orally moved to continue the Prehearing Conference and the Due Process Hearing on grounds that he wanted time to retain an attorney and to prepare for the hearing. Student cited that the mediation was held on May 28, 2015, which did not give time for the Parent to prepare for the due process hearing. Additionally, Student's father was scheduled to be out of state for business and the rest of the family was scheduled for vacation. District opposed the motion. Good cause showing, the motion to continue is granted.

Accordingly, the currently scheduled hearing dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference: July 20, 2015, at 3:00 p.m.
Due Process Hearing: July 28-30, 2015, starting at 9:30 a.m. on July 28, 2015 and 9:00 a.m. on all other days, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
