ORDER FOLLOWING AND
CONTINUING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On May 26, 2015, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Mother appeared on behalf of Student. Emily Sugrue, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

1. Continuance of PHC. On June 23, 2015, Fairfield-Suisun filed a motion to dismiss the remaining issues in this matter. Student has until the close of business today, June 26, 2015, to file an opposition to that motion. Mother, representing Student, stated that she intended to file such an opposition by the end of the business day.

Because the ruling on the motion to dismiss may be dispositive and render unnecessary a PHC or a ruling on Fairfield-Suisun's pending motion to continue the hearing, the ALJ continued the PHC one business day, until ~~June~~May 29, 2015, at 3:00 p.m.

2. All other matters deferred. All other matters are deferred to the continued PHC on May 29, 2015, or until further order.
