ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND GRANTING
CONTINUANCE OF PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On July 13, 2015, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Kara Hatfield, Office of Administrative Hearings. Tania Whiteleather, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Debra Ferdman, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Long Beach Unified School District. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

All parties stipulated to a continuance of the prehearing conference on the basis of a medical emergency within District's attorney's family. OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is granted. Accordingly, the prehearing conference in this matter is continued to Friday, July 17, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. District's attorney intends to promptly file a written motion to continue the prehearing conference and due process hearing dates in this matter, with a supporting declaration. Student's attorney indicated that the motion will not be opposed, and the parties

will communicate to reach agreement and stipulation about continued dates. In the event that District's request for a continuance has not been ruled upon in advance of the prehearing conference on July 17, 2015, the motion will be heard at that time.
