ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE OF JULY 17, 2015 AND
GRANTING JOINT REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE

On July 17, 2015, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Robert Helfand, Office of Administrative Hearings. Tania Whiteleather, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Elizabeth Curtis, Para-legal, appeared on behalf of Long Beach Unified School District.¹ The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

On July 13, 2015, the parties appeared telephonically at a Prehearing Conference before ALJ Kara Hatfield. At that time, all parties stipulated to a continuance of the prehearing conference on the basis of a medical emergency within District's attorney's family. The request was granted and the matter was continued to today. It was understood that the parties would confer as to jointly requesting new dates.

On July 17, 2015, the Office of Administrative Hearings received a Joint Request for Continuance accompanied by a declaration from District counsel detailing her family medical emergency. OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is granted.
