ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
RESPONSE TO BELMONT-
REDWOOD SHORES SCHOOL
DISTRICT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On August 5, 2015, Parent on behalf of Student filed a request for extension of time to respond to Belmont-Redwood Shores School District's motion to dismiss, but did not specify the amount of time being requested. On August 6, 2015, Belmont-Redwood Shores filed an opposition to Student's request asserting that Student had not established good cause for the requested extension.

On August 10, 2015, Student filed a response to Belmont-Redwood Shore's opposition. Student's response included a declaration by Parent and supporting emails which established that Parent had retained counsel and as such was requesting to extend the time to file a response to the motion to dismiss to August 24, 2015. Counsel indicated in her email to Parent that she was on vacation until August 10, 2015, and that upon her return she would need "at least" two weeks to review the case before filing an opposition.

The request for extension to file a response is granted. Student's response to Belmont-Redwood Shores' motion to dismiss shall be filed by August 24, 2015.
