ORDER GRANTING DISTRICT'S
MOTION TO REOPEN TESTIMONY
AND CONTINUING THE HEARING
UNTIL OCTOBER 9, 2015

This matter came on for Due Process Hearing on September 15, 16, 22, and 23, 2015. On September 23, 2015, District schools were closed due to the Jewish holiday of Yom Kippur. District attempted to contact Lynn Johnson, a program specialist, to testify as a rebuttal witness, but Ms. Johnson was unavailable due to the religious holiday.

On September 24, 2015, District filed a motion to reopen testimony for the purpose of calling Ms. Johnson as a rebuttal witness. On September 25, 2015, Student filed a response to District's motion. Student did not oppose District's motion as long as Ms. Johnson appears personally.

Good cause being demonstrated, District's motion is GRANTED. Ms. Johnson shall appear personally. The hearing will be continued until Friday, October 9, 2015, at 10:30 a.m. at the offices of the District at 325 South Peck Avenue, Manhattan Beach, CA 90266. On October 9, 2015, the parties should be prepared to discuss a new closing brief schedule.
