CLOSING BRIEFS AND CLARIFYING
ISSUES

Schedule for Closing Briefing

Due process hearing was conducted on September 15, 16, 22, and 23 and October 8, 2015. The hearing was continued and record was left open at the request of the parties to permit them to submit written closing arguments. The closing briefing schedule is as follows:

Closing written arguments must be filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings by the end of business on October 30, 2015. Parties may submit a closing rebuttal brief no later than the close of business on November 4, 2015.

Clarification of Issues

At the request of the parties, the issues for hearing are stated as follows:

Whether Student's December 2014 Individualized Education Program, as amended, denied her a free appropriate public education by:

- a) Manhattan Beach's failure to conduct an appropriate triennial assessment in all areas of suspected disability, specifically Autism, prior to the December 2014 IEP meeting;
- b) Manhattan Beach determination that Student's primary special education eligibility was Other Health Impaired rather than Autism;
- c) Manhattan Beach failed to offer appropriate behavior support services (behavior consultation as needed); and

d) Manhattan Beach failed to offer appropriate goals in the area of
behavior?
