ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND DISMISSING
MATTER

On November 23, 2015, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Cole Dalton, Office of Administrative Hearings. Seshah Wolde-Tsadik, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Donald Erwin, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Los Angeles Unified School District.¹ The PHC was recorded.

During the PHC, Mr. Erwin confirmed that Los Angeles agreed to the settlement and dismissal of the matter was appropriate. Mr. Wolde-Tsadik moved to dismiss the matter, based upon the fully executed settlement agreement.²

The motion to dismiss is granted.
