ORDER FINDING MOTION FOR
STAY PUT IS MOOT

On October 23, 2015, Student filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings a motion for stay put against Newport-Mesa Unified School District that asserted that District was not implementing Student's last agreed upon and implemented educational program, the December 19, 2014 settlement agreement. At issue was the District's provision of home-hospital instruction. District did not submit a response. On November 5, 2015, OAH ordered parties to submit additional evidence by November 10, 2015. On November 10, 2015, Student submitted Notice of Settlement and Request for Status Conference, as the parties had resolved the matter. OAH vacated all dates and set a telephonic status conference.

As the parties have resolved this matter, Student's motion for stay put is moot and will not be ruled upon, without prejudiced to being re-filed if any actual controversy exists at a later date.
