ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND
DISMISSING CASE

SEPTEMBER 10, 2021

On September 10, 2021, Administrative Law Judge Theresa Ravandi, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Christian Knox, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Aimee Perry, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Roseville City School District. Heather Edwards, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Roseville Joint Union High School District. The

PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

STUDENT'S REQUEST TO DISMISS

At the start of the PHC, Student moved to dismiss this matter with prejudice as the parties executed final written settlement agreements. The agreement with Roseville Joint Union High School District was approved yesterday by its governing board. All necessary signatures were received today.

At Student's request, this matter is dismissed with prejudice. Student shall file with OAH the signature pages of the settlement agreements. All dates are vacated.
