ORDER CLARIFYING STATUS OF MATTER

OCTOBER 25, 2021

The status of this matter is as follows:

1. On October 13, 2021, the Office of Administrative Hearing, called OAH, issued a final Order Granting Motion to Amend the Complaint. As a result, all prehearing conference and hearing dates were vacated.
2. OAH issued a new Scheduling Order on October 14, 2021, setting new dates as follows:

PREHEARING CONFERENCE will be held on November 29, 2021, at 1:00 PM.

The parties must file and serve their prehearing conference statement no later than November 23, 2021. If a party already filed a prehearing conference statement, the

party can either file a new prehearing conference statement for the November 29, 2021 prehearing conference or rely on the statement already on file with OAH.

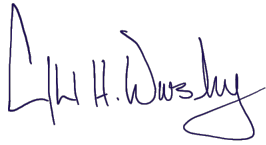
DUE PROCESS HEARING will be held on December 7, 8, and 9, 2021.

3. On October 14, 2021, California Connections Academy filed a Notice of Insufficiency. On October 18, 2021, OAH issued an Order Determining Issues Two, Three, and Four of the Amended Due Process Complaint to be Insufficient and ordering as follows:

- a. Student has until 14 days after the issuance of the order (November 1, 2021) to file an amended complaint that addresses the insufficiencies found in the Order.
- b. Student is to contact OAH staff regarding the appointment of a mediator to assist Student in identifying the issues to be included in Student's amended complaint. (Ed. Code, § 56505.)
- c. If Student does not timely file an amended complaint, Issues Two, Three, and Four will be dismissed. The due process hearing will proceed as scheduled on Student's Issue One, only.

4. The phone number OAH has for Student is not working. If Student has a working phone number, Student must provide OAH with the phone number as soon as possible.
